Psalm 23 - Hide & Seek Answers

This file gives the answers – for each one, there is an indication of the point in time within the video at which that thing first appears (for example, for question 1, person with the purple skirt first appears at 1:18 – one minute and eighteen seconds into the video). Of course, sometimes the same thing appears more than once, so you may see the same thing later in the video as well.

The person telling the story is imagining holding hands with a shepherd.



The person telling the story is holding an orange package when he's thinking about "what great things I could have".





Something with a red eye...

1:46

The "baddie" (a wolf) has a red eye – it's dark, so you can only just see it!






A shopping basket...

The teacher who is teaching about Psalm 23 is sitting in a chair.


